The Tigard-Tualatin School District's Local Option Levy (MEASURE 34-224) is up for renewal on the upcoming November 4 ballot. This property tax started in 2000 and was renewed in 2004 and 2008. **It is not a new or additional tax.** Funds from the Levy provide an estimated **\$6 million** or the equivalent of 70 teaching positions to our district.
