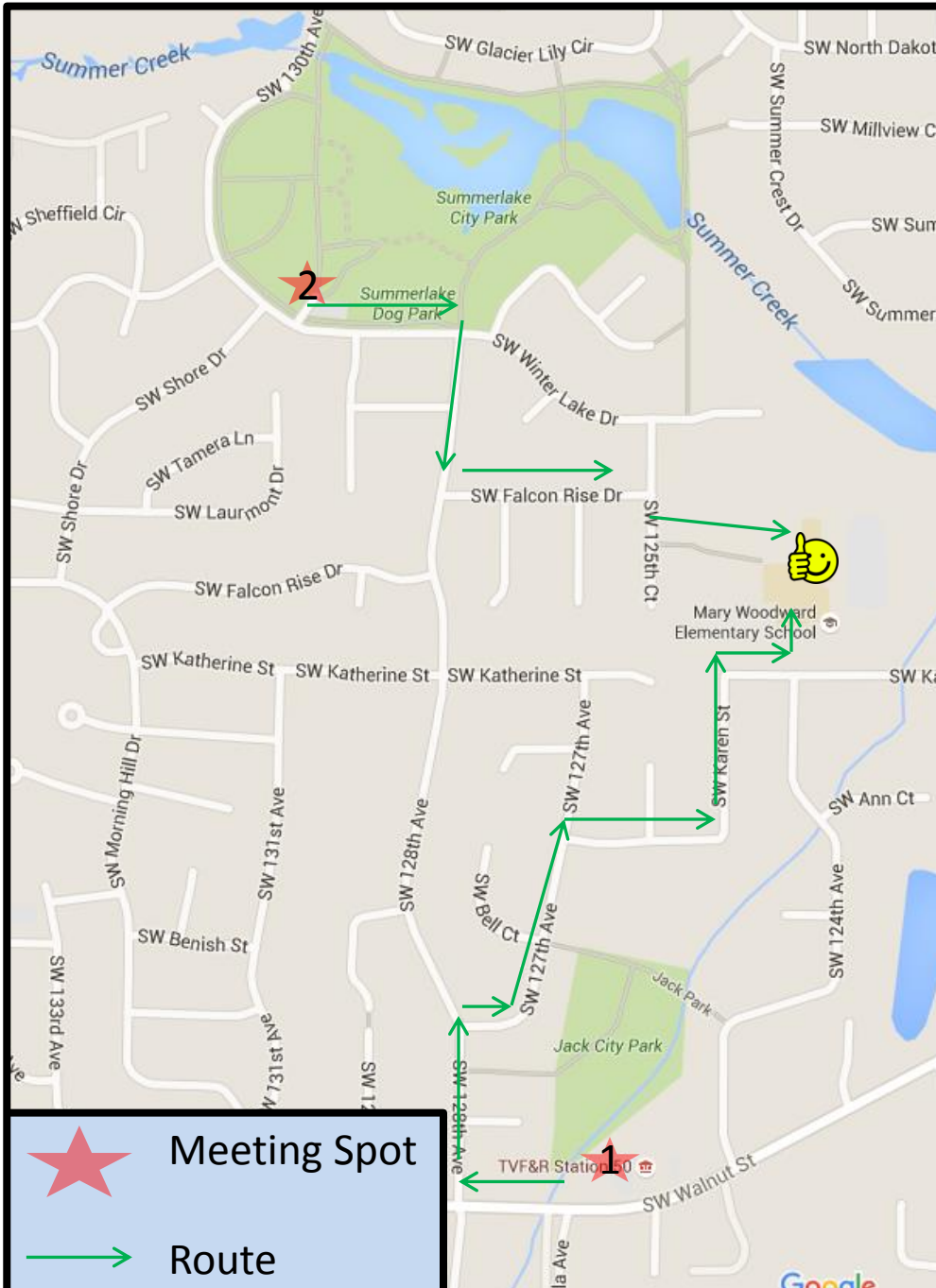


1. TVF&R Station 50 – 12617 SW Walnut
