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## Box Top Competition #1 starts soon

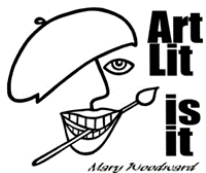
Calling all Mary Woodward parents! We have the first box top competition of the year from September 27th - December 9th.
