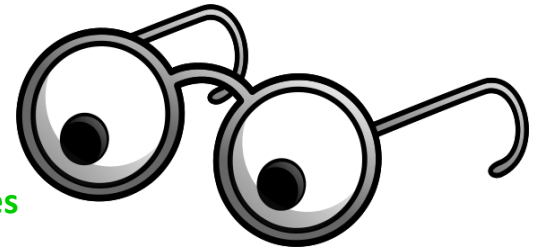


HELP!!!
