Are you planning on volunteering at Mary Woodward next year? The summer is a great time to fill out the [background check](#) so you can avoid the back-to-school rush. If you've already completed your background check, it is good for three years. If you think it's been three years since you completed your background check, watch for a notice in your email 30 days prior to expiration. You will simply need to fill out the background check again.

If you're new to volunteering, here's the scoop: All volunteers in the Tigard-Tualatin School District are required to have a background check completed before being allowed to volunteer at the school. There is no cost for the background check. The application requires that you provide your name, birthdate and driver's license (or other official ID). Background check information will be confidential between the volunteer and the school district and will not be shared.
